



### Shoot-out Procedure

⊗ = Ball.

→ Direction of restart

→ Direction of Referee

The Shootout may not be taken until the players are lined up in the proper positions. All players, **other than** the **shooter** and the defending **goalkeeper**, must take up position with at least one foot on the halfway line. The other foot may be behind the halfway line. If the opposing **goalkeeper** decides to participate, then she/he must also take up position on the halfway line, otherwise he/she can stand inside their **own penalty area**. The **shooter** is near the ball, and the defending **goalkeeper** must be standing with both feet on the goal line. The offending player ● is placed in the penalty box by the referee who awarded the penal time-penalty. The other referee retrieves the ball, ⊗ and places it on the center of the zone-line nearest to the **defending team's** penalty area.

The trail referee R2 should position back behind the restart and be ready to move outward and toward the dasher boards. R2 can watch for encroachment by the players on the half-way line. The lead referee R1 is in position to judge goalkeeper movement and the attacker's movement. The lead referee R1 has the whistle, while R2 watches the clock to note the time the time penalty countdown starts. If there is any time limit for completion of the shootout, R2 has the responsibility for this time limit too.

On the whistle, all players GO! The **shooter** may touch the ball as many times as he/she wants, and the **goalkeeper may move** once the whistle is blown.
